Thursday 13th December 2018

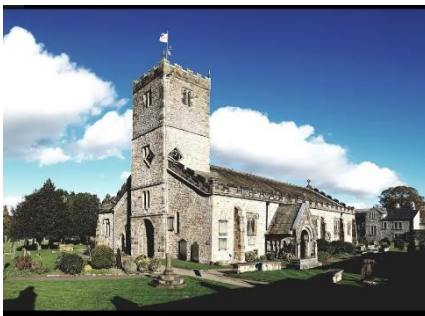
Clapham, Kirkby Lonsdale and Sedbergh were once connected by the Ingleton branch of the North Western Railway, but it was closed in 1967 in favour of the Settle Carlisle line.

10:45 to 11:45 St James, Clapham

6 bells; 10 – 2 – 2 in G Postcode: **LA2 8DT**
In 2009, the old ring of three bells was augmented to six. Since then, a ringing gallery has been installed as part of a major restoration project completed in 2015 and the bells are now available again. There is a toilet in church and parking is available on the road outside the churchyard. Turn left off the A65 onto the B6480 into Clapham. After 0.5 mile turn left at the New Inn into Church Avenue and continue until you see the church.



12:30 to 13:30 St Mary the Virgin, Kirkby Lonsdale



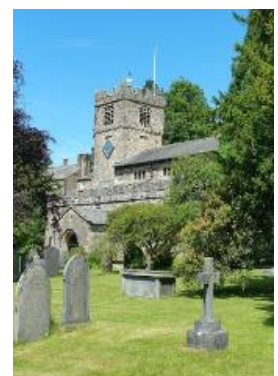
6 bells; 12 – 1 – 23 in F# Postcode: **LA6 2AX**
The six bells were cast in 1825 by Thomas Mears. There is a toilet in the church. Access to the tower is by a spiral staircase. Some car parking is available outside the church yard on the B6254. The nearest public car park is probably on New Road, B6446 (LA6 2AD), about 5 minutes from the church. For the car park take the right turn off the A65 onto the B6254 Main St, turn left into New Rd where the carpark is on the left.

13:30 to 15:00 Lunch at The Orange Tree, Kirkby Lonsdale

The pub is only a 2 minute walk away from the church. Postcode: **LA6 2BD**.

8 bells; 15 – 1 – 25 in F Postcode: **LA10 5BZ**
Parking is available in the town car park beyond the church and downhill on Loftus Hill (LA10 5RX) or there is limited street parking. The bells are rung from a gallery which looks out over the nave. Toilets are available in the church.
